Subject: Hayes Lemmerz - Maxion Wheel Welds

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the Canadian Motor Vehicles Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC, on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division and wholly owned subsidiary, Western Star Truck Sales, Inc., has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner 108SD, 114SD, Business Class M2, Cascadia, Columbia, and Coronado vehicles and Western Star 4700 and 4900 vehicles manufactured March 16, 2012, through April 30, 2012.

On vehicles containing certain Hayes Lemmerz - Maxion Wheels, the fusion between the wheel disc and rim may be inadequate, creating a possible separation of the disc from the rim. A rim partially separated from the disc may affect vehicle handling. In the worst case the rim may become fully separated from the disc potentially leading to a crash or creating a road hazard.

This is the first of two notices you will receive regarding this subject. This letter is to inform you of an upcoming Recall to correct the issue noted above. Daimler Trucks is currently validating the repair and securing replacement parts.

The second notice will inform you when the final remedy is available. When you receive it, please contact your authorized Daimler Trucks North America dealer to schedule the Recall for your vehicle. You may continue to operate your vehicle in the interim.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner.
