SUBJECT: Cylinder Head Gasket Failure/Liner Protrusion

NOTE: This document supersedes 08 TS-2Rev.

ISSUE

When diagnosing a cylinder head gasket failure, it is recommended that liner protrusion be measured at four locations per cylinder. Attached is a work sheet to guide you in measuring liner protrusion. If it is determined that liner protrusion is out of specification, it will be necessary for the cylinder block counter bores to be resurfaced. Refer to appropriate engine service manual for specifications on liner protrusion and instruction on how to cut liner bore. NOTE: DD13, DD15 and DD16 engines do not have tools or instructions released to cut liner counter bore at this time.
