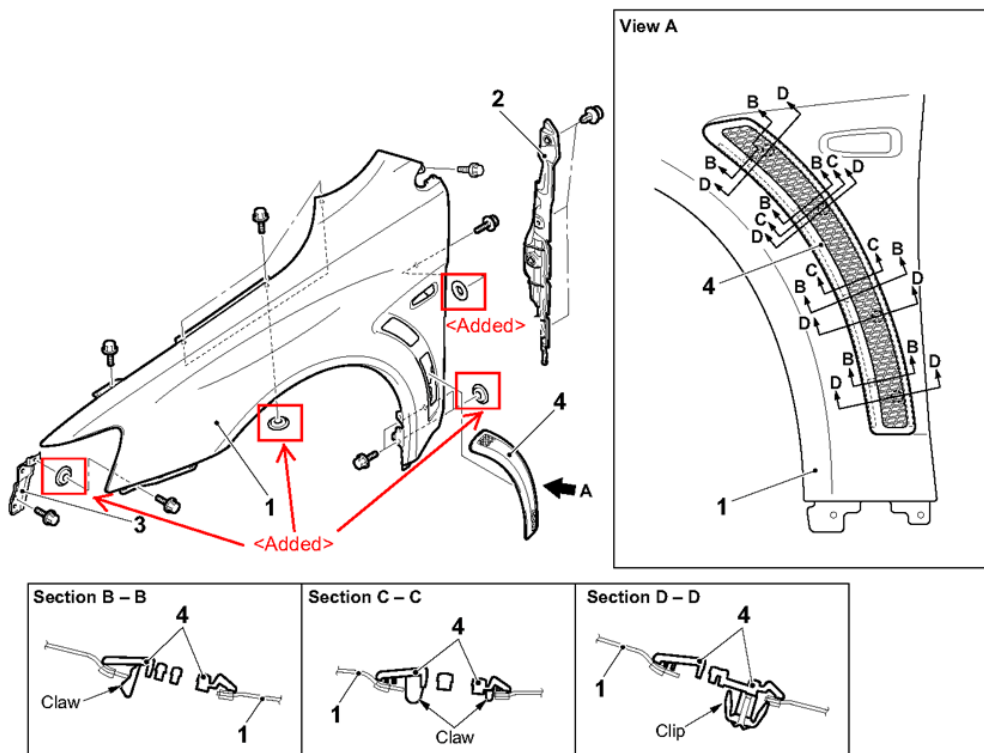

- Front splash shield removal and installation
- Side air dam removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 51, Side Air Dam .)
- Front bumper bracket removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 51, Front Bumper Assembly and Radiator Grille .)
- Front delta garnish removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 51, Garnish and Molding .)
- Front deck garnish removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 51, Windshield Wiper .)
- Headlight assembly removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 54A, Headlight .)
- Side turn signal light removal and installation (Refer to GROUP 54A, Side Turn Signal Light .)
