'Camera Fault' Message Displayed

AFFECTED VEHICLE RANGE:

Range Rover Evoque (LV) VIN: CH000447 – CH671184

Model Year: 2012

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: On vehicles fitted with the single Rear Camera only (**not** Surround Camera System vehicles), a 'Camera Fault' message may be displayed in the High Level Display Front (HLDF), the Battery Charge

warning lamp () may be illuminated, and a potential loss of Medium Speed (MS) CAN may occur.

Cause: This may be caused by water ingress into the tailgate harness causing contamination of the camera connector.

Action: In the event of a customer concern of the above, refer to the Repair Procedure outlined below to replace the tailgate harness and rear view camera.





REPAIR PROCEDURE

- △ NOTE: Do not remove the front screen when lowering the headliner.
- 1. Refer to Workshop Manual section 501-05 and lower the headlining.
- 2. Disconnect the electrical connectors.




- 3. Disconnect the ground lead.
 - Remove the ground lead retaining bolt.



4. Refer to Workshop Manual section 501-05 and remove the tailgate trim panel.


- 5. Disconnect the electrical connectors.
 - Remove the tailgate harness.



- 6. Remove the tailgate plinth.
 - Remove the eight (8) securing nuts.



7. Remove the rear view camera.



 \bigtriangleup NOTE: When installing the ground lead torque to 10Nm.

8. Reverse steps 1-7 to install the new tailgate harness and rear view camera.
