Subject: Important - Assistance For Installing The Camaro Ground Effects

Models: 2010 - 2013 Chevrolet Camaro

This PI was superseded to update model years. Please discard PIC5208B.

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

Chevrolet Accessories has posted a Camaro Ground Effects installation training video on the Accessory Information Center (AIC) website to assist ADIs and Dealers with proper installation of the Ground Effects package.

Recommendation/Instructions

The GM Technical Assistance Center has received calls related to the GM Accessory Camaro Ground Effects and problems with the front air dam coming loose. After review of each of the calls it was determined that the installation instructions were not completely followed.

It is important to make sure that all of the front attachment rivets are installed.

Do not use petroleum based cleaning products. If a strong cleaner is required use a 3M general purpose cleaner (P/N 08984). Tape will not adhere to a surface with residue left from petroleum based cleaning products.

Be sure to apply 15 lbs. of pressure to the tape for proper wet out. After the kit has been installed the car should not be driven for 24 hours. The tape that is used during the installation of the front air dam must sit for 24 hours for complete adhesion.

Remember there are two different Ground Effect Kits available.

One is only used on the base model Camaro, the other is only used on the SS model Camaro.

Please make sure your technicians or accessory installers are aware of this information.
