INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform you of a change made to the rear ABS Wheel Speed Sensors. For manufacturing purposes, the length of the wiring harness was increased by 15mm. A bracket was also added to the rear upper arm assembly to secure the harness.

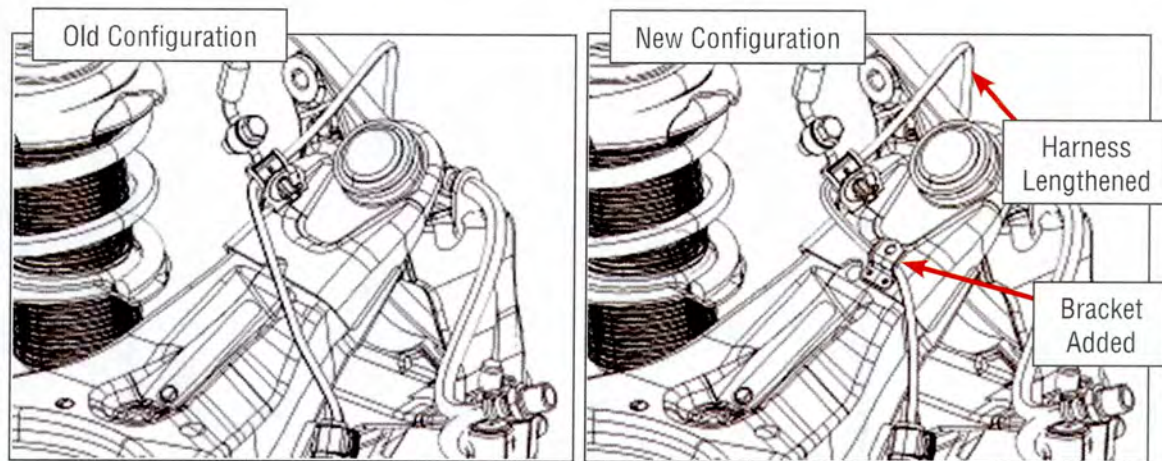
