Front Windshield Glass Delaminating

AFFECTED VEHICLE RANGE:

XF (X250) with Heated Front Windshield only VIN: R00001 - S05128

Model Year: 2009 - 2011

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: On vehicles fitted with a heated front windshield, the front windshield glass may appear to be separating / bubbling along the top or side edges. This may be caused by poor adhesion of the glass laminates.

Action: In the event of a customer concern of the above, refer to the Repair Procedure outlined below to replace the heated front windshield.

△ NOTE: Only a Jaguar windshield may be replaced as a Warranty claim.

- 1. Inspect front windshield glass for delaminating / bubbling and is a Jaguar windshield ('JAGUAR' in the lower left-hand corner).
 - If the glass shows signs of delaminating / bubbling, continue to step 2.
