CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: After opening any door with the exterior handle, the following may occur:

- The exterior door handle may 'stick' in the open position
- The door may not latch; and
- With the ignition 'ON', the 'door open' warning may be activated

Action: In the event of a customer concern of the above, refer to the Repair Procedure outlined below to rework the affected door(s) exterior handle.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

REWORK EXTERIOR DOOR HANDLE(S)

CAUTION: Make sure no damage is caused to the vehicle or the vehicles paint work.



- Refer to Workshop Manual section 501-14: Handles, Locks, Latches and Entry Systems, and remove the affected door handle:
 - Perform steps 1-2 only.

CAUTION: Make sure no damage is caused to the vehicle or its paint work.

- 2. Use a suitable tool to remove the molded rib on both sides of the handle.
 - Make sure that all the excess plastic has been fully removed from the door handle.



- 3. Refer to Workshop Manual section 501-14: *Handles, Locks, Latches and Entry Systems*, and install the reworked door handle.
- 4. Verify door handle operation.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 on each affected exterior door handle.
