Front or rear seat belt does not roll up correctly.

Cause:

Dirt deposits on the seat belt guide due to a soiled seat belt.

Remedy:

Cleaning of the belt guide.

Clean the belt guide using MB Plastic Cleaner.

Clean the seat belts using MB Car Wash mixed with water or MB Upholstery Foam Cleaner. Do not treat the belt with other cleaning agents. Clean using MB Car Wash mixed with water, MB Upholstery Foam Cleaner or clean, lukewarm water and soap. Do not dry at temperatures above 80 °C or in direct sunlight, do not bleach or dye.
