Subject: Retrofitting Timing Chain Guide

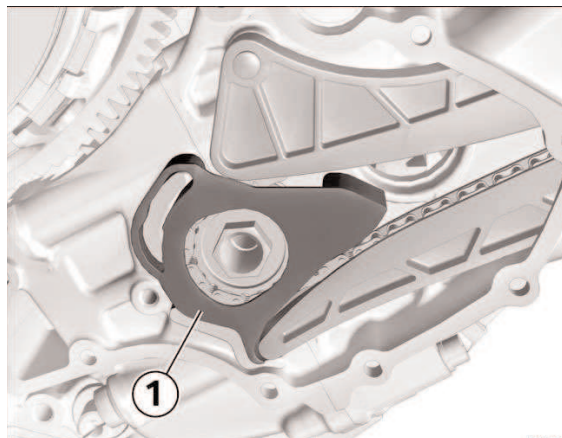
Models: K 1200 S (K40), K 1200 R (K43), K 1200 R Sport (K43/HV), K 1200 GT (K44), K 1300 S (K40/11), K 1300 R (K43/11), K 1300 GT (K44/31)

Details: BMW Motorrad has ascertained that on engines that have reached high mileage, the timing chain can stretch due to normal wear. In isolated cases, this can result in the timing chain slipping over the crankshaft gear before hydraulic pressure can build up in the chain tensioner when the engine is being started. The outcome can be damage to the valve train.

Motorcycles affected: In order to determine if a specific motorcycle is affected by this Technical Campaign, it will be necessary to verify all motorcycle VINs through a DCS Vehicle History Check. Based on the response of the system, either proceed with the repair or take no further action. Please note, affected VINs may not appear until 24-48 hours after the release of this bulletin.

Production Solution: A chain guide designed to prevent the timing chain from slipping has been installed as of December 2010. At the time of this production update, the check for chain guide (and installation if needed) was added to the maintenance interval during a valve check.

Aftersales Solution: When a motorcycle affected by this Technical Campaign is brought in for its next BMW service, it is to be checked, and if needed, the chain guide is to be retrofitted. See work item 11 11 515 on the latest RSD (Repair and Service Data BMW Motorrad) DVD for a description of the procedure for installing the chain guide.
