Introduction

Some 2013 model year ES 350 and 2012 – 2013 model year RX 350 vehicles may exhibit a MIL "ON" condition with Diagnostic Trouble Code (DTC) P219A or P219B present. The Engine Control Module/ECM (SAE term: Powertrain Control Module/PCM) logic has been modified to reduce the possibility of this condition occurring. Please follow the repair procedure below to address this condition.

1. Using TIS Techstream, confirm one of the following DTCs are present:



- P219A Bank 1 Air-Fuel Ratio Imbalance
- · P219B Bank 2 Air-Fuel Ratio Imbalance

If other DTCs are present, this bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis per Repair Manual procedures.

2. Check for the Authorized Modifications Label affixed to the vehicle in the location shown in the applicable Figure below. Confirm if the ECM (PCM) calibration has been updated. If the calibration ID listed is NOT the latest ECM (PCM) calibration — go to step 3.

Figure 1. Location of Authorized Modifications Label on 2013 ES 350





3. Flash reprogram the ECM (PCM).

NOTE

- The GR8 Battery Diagnostic Station MUST be used in Power Supply Mode to maintain battery voltage at 13.5 volts while flash reprogramming the vehicle.
- For details on how to use the GR8 Battery Diagnostic Station, refer to the GR8 Instruction Manual located on the Technical Information System (TIS), Diagnostics - Tools & Equipment - Battery Diagnostics.

Follow the procedures outlined in Service Bulletin L-SB-0015-10, "Techstream ECU Flash Reprogramming Procedure," and flash the ECM (PCM) with the NEW calibration file update.

- 4. Install the Authorized Modifications Label.
 - A. Using a permanent marker, enter the following information on the label:
 - ECM part number [Refer to the Parts Information section for the NEW PART NUMBER]
 - Calibration ID(s) [Refer to the Calibration Information section for the NEW CALIBRATION ID]

 - Change Authority [This bulletin number]
 - B. Affix the Authorized Modifications Label to the vehicle at the location shown in Figure 1 or 2. The Authorized Modifications Label is available through the MDC, P/N 00451-00001-LBL.
- 5. Test drive the vehicle to confirm proper vehicle operation.
