2013 CX-5

#### DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may experience steering shimmy/shake and/or floor vibration while driving between 50-80 mph. This concern may be caused by unbalanced wheels/tires.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

#### **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

- 1. Verify the customer concern.
- 2. Balance all four (4) wheels/tires according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 02-12 WHEEL BALANCE ADJUSTMENT (ALUMINUM ALLOY WHEEL)).
  - **NOTE:** To achieve the best wheel balancing results, Mazda recommends using the Hunter Road Force® GSP9700 wheel balancer. To find the location of a GSP9700 near your dealer, visit Hunter's web site at www.gsp9700.com and click on "Locate a GSP9700".
- 3. Verify the repair.
  - **NOTE:** If balancing all four (4) wheel/tires does not resolve the concern, contact the Mazda Technical Assistance Hotline for further assistance.
