

To get Pandora to play again, the Pandora application needs to be restarted. This is caused by improper software of the Bluetooth unit. To correct the problem, the software of the Bluetooth unit has been changed.





- 4. Remove the screws (A) securing the Bluetooth unit (B).




5. Disconnect the connectors (A) of the Bluetooth unit (B), then detach the clips (C).
