PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Seat Speaker Buzz or Rattle Noise

Models: 2013 Cadillac XTS Equipped with Radio RPO UQS Built Prior to October 4, 2012

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a speaker buzz or rattle noise during radio use. The screws attaching the speakers may be loose, causing a rattle or buzz noise.

Recommendation/Instructions

Replace the speaker attachment screws with newly designed screws that are longer and have wider threads to retain torque.

Replace the speaker screws on all four speakers in the driver and passenger seats following the procedure below:



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1. Insert a pick into the speaker hole at the rear of the grille towards the center of the seat. Pry up the grille at the front then move towards the outboard side of the grille. Use a small prying object under the pick so not to damage the speaker bezel.



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- 2. Remove the speaker attachment screws.
- 3. Install the new longer speaker attachment screws.

Important: DO NOT overtighten the new attachment screws. Overtightening will cause the speaker bezel to bow and warp making installation of the speaker grilles difficult. This can also cause damage to the bezel.

4. Install the speaker grilles.
