Models: 2012-2013 Chevrolet Cruze

Equipped without W1Y (Steering Wheel Controls)

This PI is being revised to add the 2013 model year, update Recommendations/Instructions and update Parts Information. Please discard PI0791.

Condition/Concern

Technicians may find that the accessory cruise control (P/N 95081936) is inoperative after installation and BCM programming is complete. **Important:** This condition does not apply to vehicles equipped with W1Y (Steering Wheel Controls) and accessory cruise control package P/N 95081937.

Vehicles equipped without steering wheel controls (W1Y) require steering wheel airbag coil replacement to enable accessory cruise control operation.

Recommendation/Instructions

Installation of the accessory cruise control package (P/N 95081936) also requires the replacement of the steering wheel airbag coil to enable the operation of the accessory cruise control. Refer to Cruise Control Package Installation in the Accessory Installation Manual in SI.
