# SUBJECT: SERVICE ACTION: INSPECTION FOR NOISE FROM ENGINE UNDER SPECIFIC CONDITIONS (SA 134)

# **\***NOTICE

This bulletin has been revised to include additional information. New/revised sections of this bulletin are indicated by a black bar in the margin.

This bulletin provides information relating to certain RIO (UB) 2013 Y vehicles which may exhibit abnormal engine noises, including "rattling" and "chattering", unler specific conotions. Only a very small number of vehicles within the identified Production Date range via actually be affected; make sure to follow the detailed instructions and recently updated inspection procedure in this bulletin to prevent unnecessary angine replacements. This procedure applies to vehicles produced from August 09, 2012 to actuate 09, 2012 this is requesting the completion of this Service Action on all affected relaces in dealer stock prior to delivery. Before conducting the procedure, verify the vehicles included in the list Causated VINs.

# \*NOTICE

A Service Action is a repair program without customer notification that is performed during the warranty period. Any dealed requesting to perform this repair outside the warranty period will require DPSM approved

Repair status for a VN is provided on WebDCS (Service> Warranty Coverage> Warranty Coverage Inquiry> Compaign Information). Not completed Recall / Service Action reports are available on WebDCS (Consumer Affairs> Not Completed Recall> Recall VIN> Select Report), which includes a list of affected vehicles.

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#### **Diagnosis Procedure:**

- 1. Familiarize yourself with the specific noise by reviewing the sound files below:
  - Mormal Sound (Mid) Abnormal Sound (HIGH) Abnormal Sound (Mid) Abnormal Sound (Low)
- 2. Open the hood.
- 3. Start the engine.

Additional Test

- 4. Turn off all accessories (air conditioning, radio etc.).
- 5. Close all doors and windows.
- 6. For vehicles with **AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSIONS:** Place shift lever in Park while conducting diagnosis test. For vehicles with **MANUAL TRANSMISSIONS:** Place shift lever in Neutral and apply parking brake to prevent vehicle movement during diagnosis test.
- 7. Perform diagnosis procedure below, adhering to the updated specific speed and time narameters of each step.



\*ECU will lower engine RPM to idle at step C and E after 20 seconds. Perform steps C and E three times to meet the specified test time requirement.

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#### NOTES FOR BASIC TEST

- Increase engine RPM in a gradual manner, according to the test times shown in the table above.
- After performing Step C of the test for 20 seconds (at 5,000 RPM), ECU logic will protect the engine by decreasing RPM. When this occurs, increase engine speed to 5,000 RPM again to meet the specified test time requirement.
- While performing Step D, allow engine RPM to decrease gradually and check for any chattering noise coming from the engine. Abnormal engine noise may occur in all sections, but it will be heard most prominently during Step D (idle~3000 RPM).
- 8. If after completing all the test parameters of the basic test section (Steps A~D), no abnormal noises have been detected, perform the additional test section (Steps E~F) 1 or 2 times to reconfirm that no abnormal noises are present. If no abnormal engine noises are detected, no further action is required. If chattering noises are detected, follow the instructions provided in the service procedure below.

#### NOTES FOR ADDITIONAL TEST

- After performing Step E of the cest for 20 seconds (at 5,500 ~ 6,000 RPM), ECU logic will
  protect the engine by decreasing RPM. When this occurs, increase engine speed to 6,000
  RPM again to meet the specified test time and center.
- While performing Stop F allow engine RPM to decrease gridually and check for any chattering noise coming from the engine. Approximately and engine may occur in all sections, but it will be heard nost prominently turing Step F (idle~3090 KPM).

#### Service Procedure:

- 1. If abnormal noises consister t with the sound files above are confirmed, replace the engine (subassembly/long block) per a price procedure on KGIS.
- 2. Retain the engine coolant for reuse.

Kia is requesting that all required whicles, diagnosed with this condition, be repaired prior to release back to the owner (See warranty section for details on rental car expense reimbursement).
