**SUBJECT: 2014 MAZDA6 – THEFT-DETERRENT SYSTEM OPERATES WHEN UNLOCKING FRONT DOOR WITH MECHANICAL KEY (P/N KD45-67-5Y0G)**

---

The operating condition of the theft-deterrent system has changed as mentioned below for Mazda6 vehicles produced on and after May 08, 2013. The subject vehicles are equipped with the rear Body Control Module (BCM) part number KD45-67-5Y0G or later.

OPERATING CONDITIONS:

**NEW (BCM KD45-67-5Y0G OR LATER):** If the front door key cylinder is unlocked by the mechanical key while the theft-deterrent system is in the armed mode (stand-by), it is changed to the "alert" mode and the theft-deterrent system operates (alarm goes off).

**PREVIOUS (BCM KD45-67-5Y0F OR EARLIER):** The theft-deterrent system is disarmed ("stand-by" mode is cancelled) if the front door key cylinder is unlocked by the mechanical key, and the alarm does not go off.

**IMPORTANT:** If part number KD45-67-5Y0G or later is installed on vehicles built with KD45-67-5Y0F or earlier, operating conditions will change to the new method.
