## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

**Subject:** Memory Seat Module DTC B285A Symptom 4B

**Models:** 2014 Cadillac CTS Sedan

*This PI was superseded to reflect repair information. Please discard PIC5924.*

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

### Condition/Concern

During diagnosis, a dealer may notice DTC B285A Symptom 4B set as History in the Memory Seat Module (MSM). DTC B285A will NOT turn on any lights NOR will it give any indication that there is anything wrong with the vehicle. If DTC B285A is cleared, the MSM may again report DTC B285A Symptom 4B as History on the next ignition cycle.

### Recommendation/Instructions

A new Memory Seat Module calibration has been developed to resolve the false B285A sym4B. Please use Service Programming System (SPS) in TIS2WEB to reprogram the MSM with the latest available calibration.
