Subject: Unwanted Brake Apply While Backing Up

Models: 2013 Cadillac ATS with Driver Assist Package (RPO Y66)
2013 Cadillac SRX with Driver Assist Package (RPO PCX)
2013 Cadillac XTS with Driver Assist Package (RPO PCX)

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

A customer may comment of unwanted rear park assist alerts, and or unwanted brake apply while backing up.

Recommendation/Instructions

Please advise owners of a vehicle built with the Driver Assist option listed above that the rear bumper sensors need to be clean and free of mud, snow, and ice to work properly. If the customer feels the brakes apply or experiences unwanted rear park assist alerts while backing up, they can either clean the rear bumper or turn off the park assist and automatic rear braking by pressing the button in the picture below each ignition cycle to disable the system until the rear bumper can be cleaned.
