## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Vibration In Second And Third Gears Only

Models: 2012-2013 Buick Regal Verano

Equipped with 6 speed manual transmission RPO MR6

This PI was superseded to include repairs in administrative details. Please discard PIP5042A.

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

## Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a vibration that is only present in second and third gears when lugging the engine, example going uphill or causing engine rpm to be pulled down from being in to high of gear. The vibration will not be present at the same speed in fourth gear.

## Recommendation/Instructions

Verify that the vibration is present only in second and/or third gears. Note the engine revolutions per minute and road speed that the vibration is present then shift to fourth and maintain road speed. If no vibration is present in fourth gear verify correct shift system adjustment and if there is no change contact TAC at the number you have been provided.
