The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

Effective 05/29/12 the fuel tank assembly part numbers 25815572 or 25948766 will no longer be on Restriction through PQC.

Recommendation/Instructions

If it is determined that a Fuel Tank Assembly is necessary during repairs for the above listed vehicles and part numbers, the parts can be obtained through GMSPO.

Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
