## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

**Subject:** Mist From Instrument Panel Vents, Moisture On Windshield Or Water On Floor

**Models:** 2010 - 2013 Buick LaCrosse  
2011 - 2013 Buick Regal  
2013 Chevrolet Malibu

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

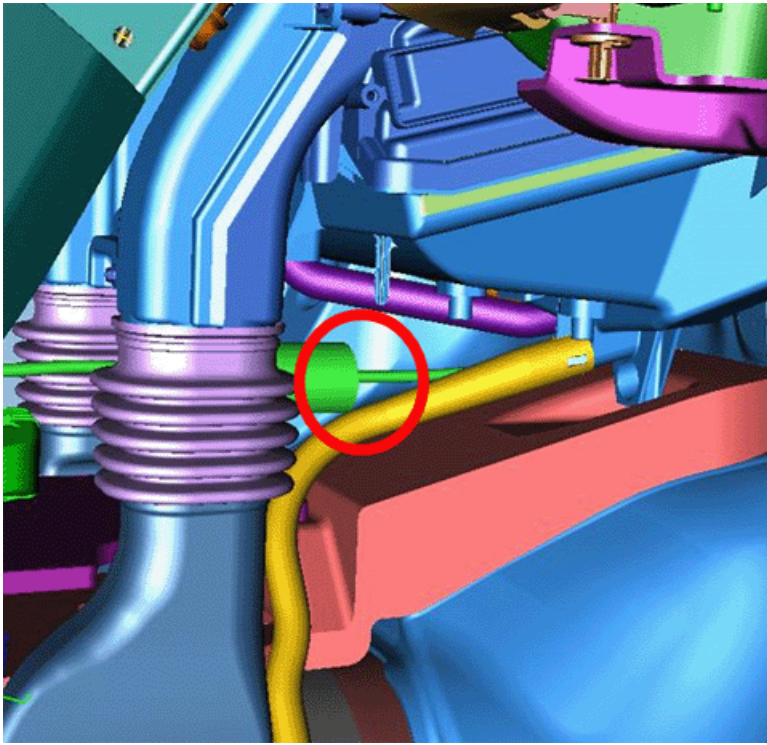
### Condition/Concern

A customer may comment that there is a mist from IP vents, moisture on inside of windshield, water drips on driver's foot or floor is wet.

### Recommendation/Instructions

Reposition the passenger side front carpet to inspect the evaporator case drain hose, the hose is likely caught on the foam isolator on the transmission shift cable. Reposition the shift cable to the driver's side of the vehicle and push slack of the cable and the insulator forward into engine compartment. See photos attached for reference.
