#### 85 Noises from blower motor

### **Condition**

Various "whistling" noises are heard from the blower motor when it is running, particularly when it is running at lower fan speeds:

- The noises may be intermittent, and may depend on the outside temperature, the position of the flaps, etc.
- The noises are subtle, and they may not be heard if the audio system is on or if the vehicle is moving.

### **Technical Background**

The noises may be caused by a section of the noise insulation on the heating and air conditioning unit.

#### **Production Solution**

Improvements to the acoustic characteristics of the heating and air conditioning unit are in development.

### **Service**

- 1. Remove the glove compartment according to the instructions in the Elsa Repair Manual.




Figure 1. Location of the sound insulation to be removed.

- Remove the section of sound insulation shown in the image at right (Figure 1). It is easily removed by pulling the retaining pin away from the housing.

- 3. Reinstall the glove compartment.
- 4. Check for blower noise again. If the noise is now gone, no further measures are necessary.
