Service

Audi of America is requesting your cooperation in supplying us with technical information regarding this condition.

- 1. Verify that for **one** of the 6 cylinders, a misfire fault (**DTC P0301 P0306**) is stored in ECM memory **with** the cylinder deactivation fault, **DTC P130A**. Also verify that the misfire is still active (after restart, misfire continues).
- 2. Contact a TAC consultant before proceeding. Do **not** delete the DTCs.
- 3. Attach the DTC and diagnostic log to the TAC ticket.
