


UHV-Low (9W2) 2009,2010 UHV-NAR (9W7), <mark>(9ZR)</mark> 2011-2013	 The UHV-Low / UHV-NAR is identified by the 3 button array located on the overhead console. Tip: LED light is not used in 9W7 Bluetooth systems. Additionally it cannot be turned on by recoding of the control module. 			
	ONote: Some M.Y. 2010 vehicles originally equipped with "9W2" system may have been			
	modified. Use Vehicle Self Diagnosis to determine the module part number and use the chart below for reference if necessary.			
Volk-L	Turn the ignition switch to the ON position.
