## 2014 Passat – Car-Net™ Operating Control Unit (OCU) Not Available in ODIS Self-Test Menu

On 2014 Passat, ODIS Service does not display **75 – Emergency call module & comm unit** in the self-test menu. To correct the issue, a file must be updated and a Hotfix needs to be installed.



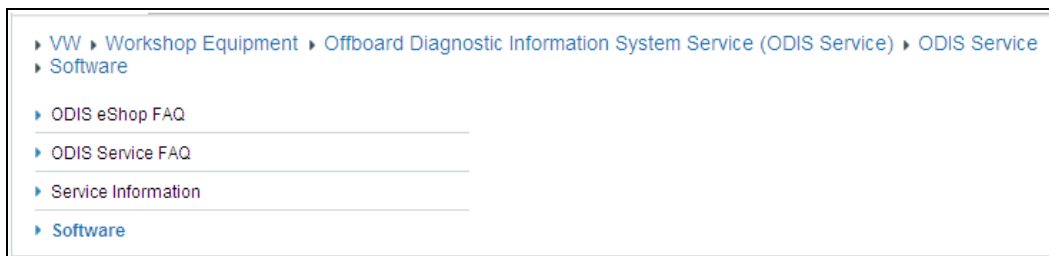
### Note:

**The file update needs to run only one time. The Hotfix will need to be installed each time ODIS is restarted.**

This update only applies to 2014 Passat and ODIS Service version 1.2.1 only.

To update the tester, follow the steps below:

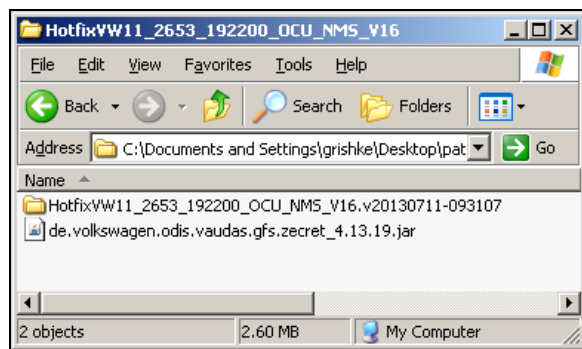
1. Log in to ServiceNet to download the update package.
2. Go to VW / Workshop Equipment / Offboard Diagnostic Information System Service (ODIS Service) / ODIS Service / Software. The link is **2014 Passat CarNet Hotfix Update**.



3. Download the file **HotfixVW11\_2653\_192200\_OCU\_NMS\_V16.zip**

4. Extract the files and copy to the tester desktop.

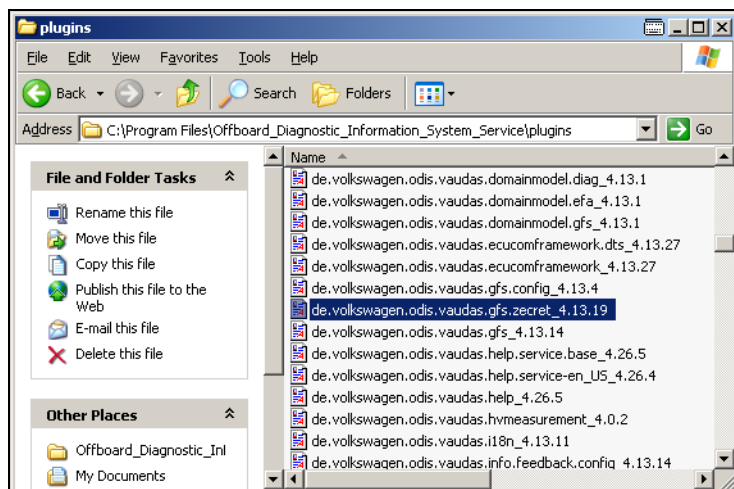
There should be 1 folder (**HotfixVW11\_2653\_192200\_OCU\_NMS\_V16.v20130711-093107**) and 1 file (**de.volkswagen.odis.vaudas.gfs.zecret\_4.13.19.jar**).



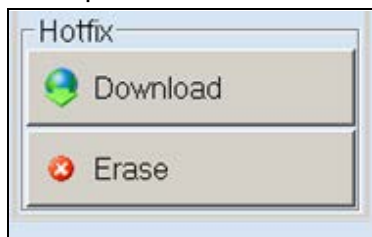

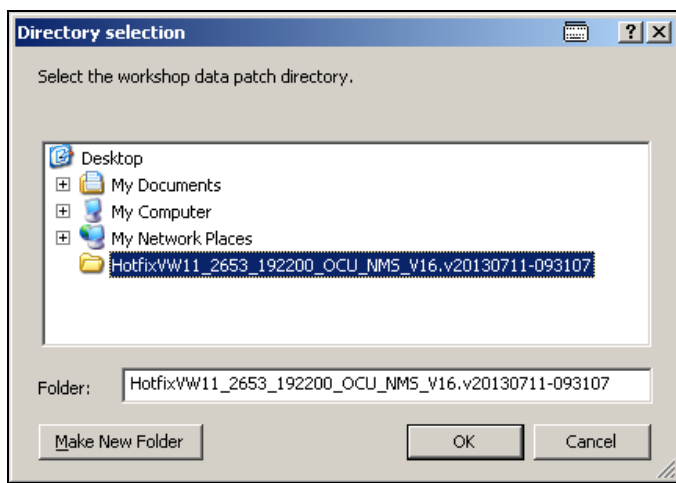
5. If necessary, close the ODIS application. Copy the file **de.volkswagen.odis.vaudas.gfs.zecret\_4.13.19.jar** to the directory **C:\Program Files\Offboard\_Diagnostic\_Information\_System\_Service\Plugins**.



6. Start the ODIS application. Before starting a diagnostic session, in the right toolbar, scroll down and expand the Data section. In the Hotfix section, click on the **Download** button.



7. Navigate to the desktop and select the Hotfix folder. Click **OK**.

8. Click **OK** to close the confirmation dialog.



9. ODIS should now display **75 – Emergency call module & comm unit** in the self-test menu.
