#### Subject: Diagnostic Tip for DTCs U183E, U184B, U184D and U0140 Set After Vehicle Has Been in Transport Mode

#### Models: 2014 Chevrolet Spark EV

### **Condition/Concern**

Technicians may find DTCs U183E, U184B, U184D and U0140 stored in history.

This condition may be caused by the vehicle left in transport mode.

#### **Recommendation/Instructions**

Clear the DTCs and turn off the transport mode. For information regarding turning the transport mode off, refer to the latest version of Bulletin Number 11-08-49-001.
