Introduction

Some 2013 model year Avalon XLE and Avalon HV XLE vehicles may exhibit front seat heaters remaining ON in the lowest setting even when the seat heater switch is OFF. Replace the seat heater switch (Refreshing Seat Switch) to address this condition.
