Introduction

Some 2010 model year Tacoma vehicles equipped with the 2TR-FE engine may exhibit a front exhaust pipe catalyst rattle noise and/or MIL "ON" condition with DTC P0420 (Catalyst System Efficiency Below Threshold) stored in the Engine Control Module (ECM) (SAE Term: Powertrain Control Module/PCM). Refer to the repair procedure to address this condition.

- 1. Test drive and verify that an abnormal rattle noise is heard while accelerating.
- 2. Raise the vehicle on a hoist with the engine running.


Repair Procedure (Continued)

3. Increase the engine speed and listen to the catalytic converter section on the front exhaust pipe assembly for a rattle noise.

CAUTION

Avoid contacting any part of the exhaust system – it is VERY HOT.

- 4. Did the noise appear to be the loudest at the catalytic converter section of the front exhaust pipe assembly?

 - NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 5. Replace the front exhaust pipe assembly.
