

# **Service Bulletin**

## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Front Grille Mounted Z71 Emblem Loose or Missing

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 with RPO Z71 Built Prior to September 12, 2013

#### **Condition/Concern**



Some customers may comment that the front grille mounted Z71 emblem is loose or missing.

This condition may be caused by a failure of the adhesive tape used to attach the emblem to the grille.

#### **Recommendation/Instructions**

Use the following steps to install a replacement emblem that has revised adhesive material:

- Remove the loose emblem and adhesive residue if necessary. Clean the grille surface using an isopropyl alcohol and water solution (50/50) or \*3M General Purpose Adhesive Cleaner, 3M P/N 08987 or Acrysol Body Solvent (Kent Auto), or equivalent, to ensure that the surface is free of contaminants such as dust, oils, wax, moisture, etc.
- 2. Warm the mounting surface of the grille using a heat gun. Hold the heat gun, J-25070, 152+mm (6.0+in) from the surface to warm the grille to approximately 70°F (21°C). Use care. If overheating occurs, the grille finish may be damaged.

Important: Failure to use promoter may reduce the adhesion properties of the mounting tape.

- 3. Wipe the emblem mounting area with \*3M Automotive Adhesion Promoter, 3M P/N 06396.
- 4. Once the surface of the grille has been prepped, warm the emblem, hold the heat gun 152+mm (6.0+in) from the emblem and heat the front and back of the emblem using a circular motion for 30 seconds, making the emblem pliable.

Important: Do not touch the adhesive of the emblem.

- 5. Remove the backing film from the emblem.
- 6. Immediately locate the emblem to the correct position on the grille.
- 7. Using a roller, apply pressure evenly along the entire surface of the emblem to ensure proper adhesion.
- 8. Inspect the emblem for gaps and bonding.
