Subject: Normal Characteristic – Electric Parking Brake (EPB) Auto-Apply for System Self Test

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Spark EV

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that the parking brake has self applied.

The electric parking brake (EPB) will perform a self-test by auto-applying after a park/key-off event if no previous EPB usage is observed for 50 ignition cycles. When this occurs, the customer can either release the parking brake prior to the next drive cycle or use the EPB Auto-Release function when moving forward.

Recommendation/Instructions

No repairs should be attempted. This is a normal operation of the vehicle.

Customer Information

Please communicate to the customer this condition is a normal operating characteristic of their vehicle. It will not impact the designed performance or reliability of the vehicle. Please share this information with the customer, including a copy of this message.
