Subject: Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) On, Various O2 Sensor DTCs Set

Models: 2011-2013 Chevrolet Express Cut Away Van

2011-2013 GMC Savana Cut Away Van

Equipped with 4.8L or 6.0L V8 Engine (RPOs L20, LC8, L96)

Built Prior to November 26, 2012

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on an Malfunction Indicator Lamp on. Technicians may find post O2 sensor failure codes current or set in history. Moisture may be splashing on the hot O2 sensors and causing them to crack.

Recommendation/Instructions

Replace both O2 sensors and install the new ECM service calibration.

The new O2 sensors are more resistant to cracking. They are also internally wired differently than the OE sensors and require ECM reprogramming.

Refer to Heated Oxygen Sensor Replacement procedure in SI and reprogram the ECM using the Service Programming System (SPS) with the latest calibrations available on TIS2WEB. Refer to the SPS procedures in SI.

For 2012 model year vehicles only, after reprogramming the ECM, the BPP (brake pedal position) learn procedure must be performed.

The following 2013 LPG VINs need to have the new ECM service calibration and O2 sensors installed. All VINS beyond this breakpoint will have the current calibrations.
