Title: Exporting Vehicle Trip Report Data with Servicemaxx

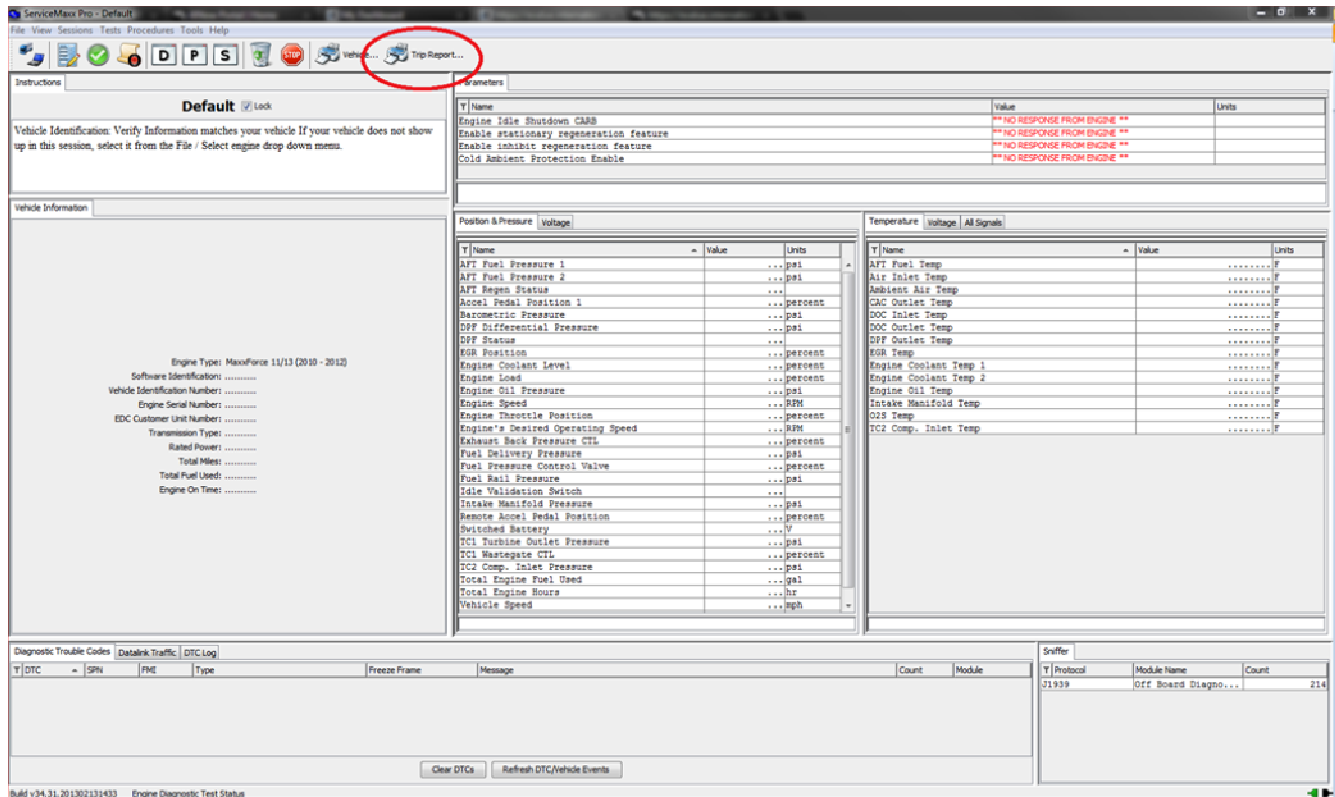
Applies To: 2010 Emissions Maxxforce 11L, 13L, and 15L

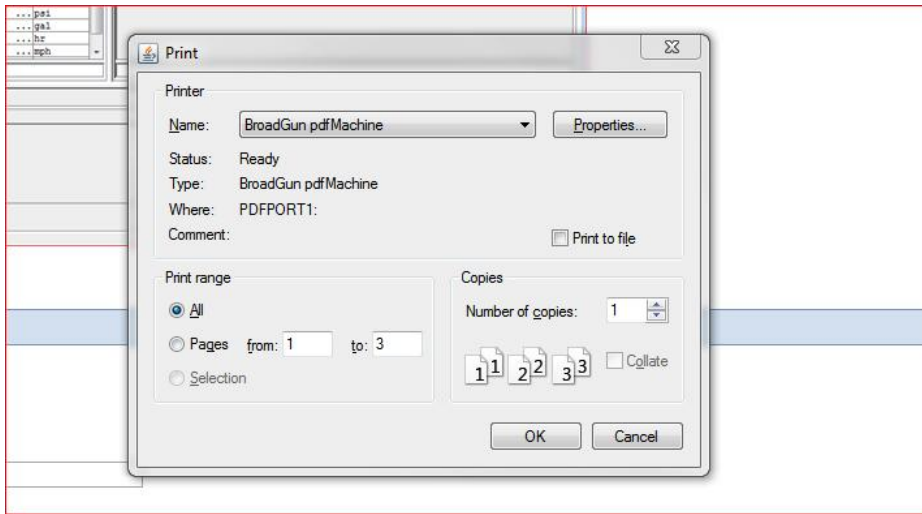
### DESCRIPTION

This article is to show the proper procedure for exporting and saving the Trip Report Data file that we may request at times. This data should be attached for ALL engine replacement approvals and engine overspeed case files for 2010 11,13, and 15L engines. It may also be requested for other conditions as well.

### PROCEDURE

1. Load Servicemaxx and establish a connection with the ECM. On the Default (Home) page, check the upper right hand corner of the screen. Click on the printer icon labeled "Trip Report". Once all parameters finish loading, choose "Print to PDF" to save the Trip Report Data as a PDF document. **Note: If you do not have the option to "Print to PDF", you will need to print and scan the papers. Not all versions of Adobe will support this. Verify the save location and it can then be attached as a normal document to the case file.**
