Subject Brake Hose Clip

Background Information

We have identified that the brake hose clip fitted to the front mudguard on the above models must be replaced. Dealers are requested to remove and replace the clip and, repair/replace the front mudguard if it has been damaged by the brake hoses.

Customer Contact Instructions

Motorcycles in the affected VIN range must be modified prior to delivery to the customer, or at the next service/visit to the dealership.

Genuine Parts Ordering Instructions. . . . For Triumph Subsidiary and Overseas Distributor dealers using Triumph Warranty On-Line with Parts Auto Ordering Flag switched on: Order all repair parts by submitting a New Prior through the Warranty On-Line system. Entering the above repair code in a New Prior will automatically add the parts required and labour times for this Service Bulletin.

For Overseas Distributor dealers NOT using Triumph Warranty On-Line or for Overseas Distributor dealers using Triumph Warranty On-Line with Parts Auto Ordering Flag switched off: Orders should be placed using the normal parts ordering procedure.

Genuine Parts Return Instructions Dealer to retain parts for 90 days. All parts must be stored in a secure, non-public accessed area and correctly identified with a completed warranty label. Thereafter the parts must be rendered unusable prior to scrapping.

Once completed, please mark the service record book that the requirements of this bulletin have been complied with.

Replacement Procedure

Replace the brake hose clip following the procedure listed below:

Warning

Throughout the following procedure, ensure that the motorcycle is stabilised and adequately supported to prevent the risk of injury from the motorcycle falling.

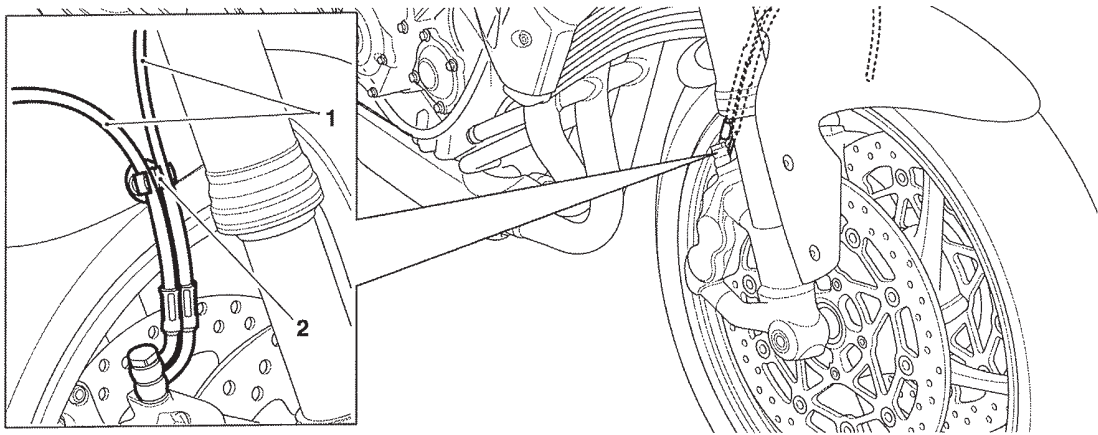
Note:

- **Some affected motorcycles listed in the VIN range on page 1 will have been modified and repaired by Triumph prior to their release from the factory.**
- **The modified motorcycles can be identified by checking the 'Outstanding Service Bulletins' on Warranty On-Line.**

Replacement

1. Detach the two brake hoses from their retaining clip on the right-hand side of the front mudguard.
2. Carefully remove the clip and retain it as described in the Genuine Parts Return Instructions on page 2.

3. Check the mudguard for damage that may have been caused by the front brake hoses.
4. **For lacquered finished mudguards only:** If the paintwork shows signs of scuffing, due to the brake hoses, apply a preparatory paint polish to the affected area using a soft cloth and work out the scuffing. If the marks can not be removed replace the mudguard and retain it as described in the Genuine Parts Return Instructions on page 2.
5. **For matt finished mudguards only:** If the paintwork shows signs of scuffing, replace the mudguard and retain it as described in the Genuine Parts Return Instructions on page 2.
6. Fit the new clip and secure the two brake hoses to it.
