CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: The sun visor vanity mirror sliding cover may open / close while driving.

Cause: This may be caused by insufficient retention of the sun visor vanity mirror sliding cover. **Action:** Should a customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction outlined below.

SERVICE INSTRUCTION:

- 1. Remove the affected sun visor (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, Section 501-05).
- **2.** Lightly tap the bottom of the sun visor.
 - If the vanity mirror sliding cover opens and is loose, continue to step 3.




3. Remove the sun visor vanity mirror pack.


4. Remove the sun visor vanity mirror pack as shown.




5. Apply felt tape (40mm X 8mm X 1mm) from the Squeaks & Rattles Kit to sun visor vanity mirror at the both ends of the top and bottom edges of the vanity mirror bezel as shown.




6. Install the sun visor vanity mirror pack, making sure no material is overhanging.



- 7. Open and close the vanity mirror sliding cover:
 - Make sure there is no dirt or scratch marks on sliding cover face.
 - Make sure the mirror is not cracked and close sliding cover.



- **8.** Lightly tap the bottom of the sun visor.
 - If the vanity mirror sliding cover does not open and is not loose, continue to step 9.
 - If the vanity mirror sliding cover opens and is loose, replace the sun visor.



- 9. Install the sun visor (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, Section 501-05).
 - Make sure that the vanity light is working when the vanity mirror sliding cover is pulled back.
- **10.** If required, repeat steps 1-9 on the other sun visor.
