Rear Seat Power Fold Feature Increase In Operational Time

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: The rear seat power fold function may not operate after the vehicle ignition has been switched 'OFF' for a period of three (3) minutes if the tailgate has been opened and a passenger compartment door has been opened and closed.

Cause: This may be caused by software issues.

Action: Should a customer express concern, follow the Service Instruction outlined below.

SERVICE INSTRUCTION:

1.  **CAUTION: A Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply must be connected to the vehicle battery during IDS / SDD diagnosis / module programming.**



NOTE: IDS must be loaded with DVD134.02 v.134 or later.

Connect the Jaguar Land Rover-approved Midtronics battery power supply to the vehicle battery.

2. Turn ignition 'ON' (engine not running).
3. Connect the Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) to the vehicle and begin a new Symptom Driven Diagnostics (SDD) session.
4. Follow the on-screen prompts, allowing SDD to read the VIN and identify the vehicle and initiating the data collect sequence.
5. Select 'Campaign' from the Session Type screen.
6. Select the 'Recommendations' tab, and then select '**Run**' to perform the 'Seats - Rear 60/40 seat configuration' option.
7. Follow all on-screen instructions to complete this task.
8. Exit the current session.
9. Disconnect the IDS and the battery power supply from the vehicle.
