- The coolant warning light is illuminated.
- Coolant is leaking from the front intercooler radiator because of stone damage to the radiator.

Technical Background




Figure 1. Damage from front-end stone impact.

When vehicles are driven on gravel roads, there is a greater chance of front-end stone impact damage to the intercooler radiator (Figure 1).

Production Solution

Beginning with CW15 2013, a protective grill has been added.

Service

- 1. Verify that the coolant is leaking from the front intercooler radiator, and that the cause is stone damage.




Figure 2. Radiator protective grill.

- 2. Replace intercooler radiator and install a radiator protective grill (Figure 2) to prevent leaking. Follow instructions in Elsa.
