Front Door Outer Waist Seal Alignment

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: The front door alignment may appear to be uneven at the trailing edge of the outer waist seal.

Cause: This may be caused waist seal not sitting flush to the door.

Action: In the event of a customer concern of the above, refer to the Repair Procedure outlined below.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

1. Remove the exterior mirror on the affected door (TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-09).

2. 🔼 CAUTION: The exterior mirror must be


removed prior to the removal of the waist seal; failure to follow this instruction will result in damage to the vehicle.

NOTE: Note the fitted position of the component prior to removal.

NOTE: Note the fitted position of the rubber door seal in to the waist seal prior to removal.

Remove the waist seal.

- Remove the screw cover.
- Remove the two (2) Torx screws.




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CAUTION: Make sure the exterior surface of the waist seal is not damaged during this step.


Using a suitable tool, remove the section of plastic from the waist seal in the position shown.





4. Install the waist seal.

- Align the rear edge of the waist seal with the rear edge of the door
- Tighten the two (2) Torx screws to 1.2 Nm.
- Install the screw cover.



- 5. Install the exterior mirror (TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-09).
- **6.** If required, repeat steps 1-5 to the other front door.
