Discolored Quarter Glass / Waist Seals

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: The quarter glass / waist seals may become discolored.

Cause: This may be caused by the seals becoming contaminated from external sources.

Action: In the event of a customer concern of the above, refer to the Repair Procedure outlined below.

NOTE: KATS Transit Coating Remover to be locally sourced; one bottle sufficient for 10 vehicles.

Source KATS Transit Coating Remover 8077 (Jaguar part number C2C38875) from your local Jaguar Dealer.

TOOLS:


SERVICE INSTRUCTION:

1. ONOTE: Vehicle surface temp should be 16-27C (60-80F). Avoid temperature in excess of 63C (145F).

NOTE: Recommendation dilution is 1:8 KATS Transit Coating Remover: fresh water.

Using a suitable small spray bottle, mix the KATS Transit Coating Remover with fresh water (1 part remover:8 parts fresh water); shake bottle before application.

2. Rinse affected area down with fresh water to remove grit and dust.



- 3. Spray affected parts with dilution and then gently wipe with soft cotton cloth to remove staining.
- **4.** Rinse off with fresh water and dry with a **clean** soft cotton cloth.
- **5.** Make sure that the quarter glass / waist seal is aesthetically pleasing on the eye.
- 6. If required, repeat procedure to the other quarter glass / waist seals as necessary.
