

INTRODUCTION

If you receive a customer concern of the front door checkers not holding the doors securely enough in the half or fully open positions, this Bulletin informs of a change made to increase the detent force of the front door checker mechanism. The new checker provides a more positive feeling when holding the front doors half or fully open.



COUNTERMEASURE IN PRODUCTION

The new door checker mechanisms were incorporated into production on February 28, 2013.
