Introduction

This Field Repair is a follow-up to Safety Recall 213-B, which addresses a condition that causes external lights to go out when the exterior light self-test switch is activated and the truck is moving. Safety Recall 213-B disables the software and replaces the switch with a plug. This Field Repair provides instruction to re-instate the self-test functionality by re-installing the self-test switch and performing a vehicle software update.

The DWC and SIR online systems indicate chassis involved in this campaign with the designator of **"413-9"**.

Expiration Date: 05/31/2014

Resolution

Install the exterior lights self-test switch (P27-1133-032), replacing the switch plug (S67-1016) and enabling the exterior lights self-test switch software parameter.

Warranty

Peterbilt will reimburse the dealer for repairs done for the campaign for 0.5 hours of labor.

The SIR system will indicate affected chassis with the designator of **"413-9"** in the campaign field.

Submit Quick Claim "413-9"

Parts

Peterbilt will reimburse for parts purchased through PACCAR Parts (dealer net+ 30% parts mark up) according to the following table:

Labor

Peterbilt will reimburse for 0.50 hours labor for software update and switch replacement included in quick claim "413-9".

Procedure

- Update software to P30-1011-108
 - Remove the plug (S67-1016) from the exterior lights self-test switch location and replace it with a switch (P27-1133-032).
 - Enable the exterior lights self-test switch programming parameter
