



Fuel Filter Replacement Maintenance Schedule Correction - 2010 & 2013 Emission Diesel Engines

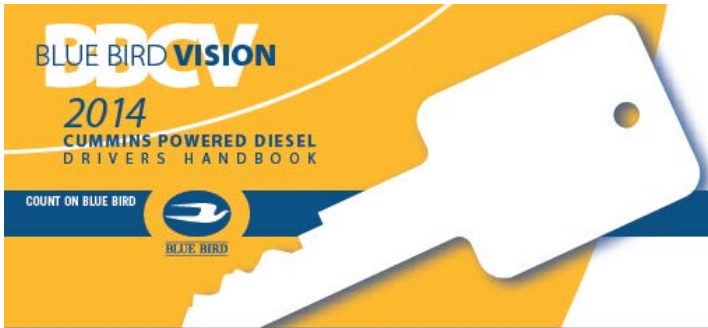
Models Affected: Service Maintenance Manuals (A3FE, A3RE, D3FE, D3RE for 2010 – 2014; BBCV for 2011 – 2014 and T3FE and T3RE for 2014) and Driver’s Hand Book (A3FE, A3RE, D3FE, D3RE for 2011 – 2014; BBCV for 2012 – 2014; T3FE and T3RE for 2014) which list a mileage only for fuel filter replacement for diesel engines.

Please update your Service Maintenance Manuals and Driver Hand Books by marking through or removing the information that states “Replace Fuel Filter “under the 60,000 Miles header section in the SPECS and MAINTENANCE with no time frame listed.

Please follow the existing section with Header “Every 6 Months or 6,000 Miles” Subtopic “Fuel Systems” states “Replace Fuel Filter Element”

Note: A fuel filter element, if not replaced per 6 months or 6,000 miles schedule, may deteriorate and contaminate the fuel system which may damage the engine fuel system.
