In addition, the defrost option may not be available in the Instrument Cluster Settings - Remote Start Menu.

## ACTION

Reprogram the Front Controls Interface Module (FCIM) to the latest calibration using IDS release 84.03 and higher or 85.01 and higher. Calibration files may also be obtained at www.motorcraft.com.
