PURPOSE


Some customers of affected vehicles may report the tongue sliding down the outer rear seat belt, becoming stuck between the seat cushion and the interior trim. This TSB instructs dealer to install a seat belt stopper button to <u>both</u> outer rear seat belts to prevent this condition.


This procedure can also be used for replacement of broken seat belt stopper buttons on other models.

AFFECTED VEHICLES

2013 – 2014 Outlander Sport built prior to approximately August 30, 2013.

PROCEDURE






1. Slide the outer seat belt tongue upwards approximately 16 inches above the seat cushion. Secure it temporarily with tape.

- 2. Measure 380mm (15 inches) up from the lower seat belt mounting bracket <u>along the center line</u> of the seat belt webbing and make a small mark.
 - NOTE: This measurement must be accurate to prevent the tongue rattling against the interior trim.

- 3. Push the spike of male side of the stopper button through the belt webbing from the resin coated side of the outer seat belt at the mark made in step 2 as shown.
- 4. Install the female side of the stopper button onto the spike on the opposite side of the belt webbing.

 Squeeze the button using a small 'C' clamp (approximately 1 ½" span) to complete installation. The clamp must flatten the spike of the male side of the button.

!! CAUTION !!

Take care to prevent damage to, or soiling of the seatbelt or other interior trim parts.

- 6. Confirm the seat belt stopper button is securely installed. The combined thickness of the installed stopper button should be 4.5–5mm.
- 7. Remove the tape securing the seat belt tongue.
- 8. Repeat for the other outer rear seat belt.
