DESCRIPTION:

If the Supplemental Restraint System Control Module (SRSCM) is replaced during service or accident repair, the unit must be programmed using the Hyundai Global Diagnostic System (GDS) before the vehicle is released to the customer. There are different variant codes that can be used when replacing the SRS Control Module on a YF/YF-HEV Sonata. If an incorrect variant code is used, the SRSCM programming will not be completed and SRS system DTCs will be stored in the SRSCM. Make sure to input the appropriate variant code following the table in the parts information section below.

Note:

The GDS menus refer to the SRSCM programming process as “ACU Variant Coding,” where ACU is an acronym for Airbag Control Unit. SRSCM and ACU both refer to the Supplemental Restraint System Control Module.

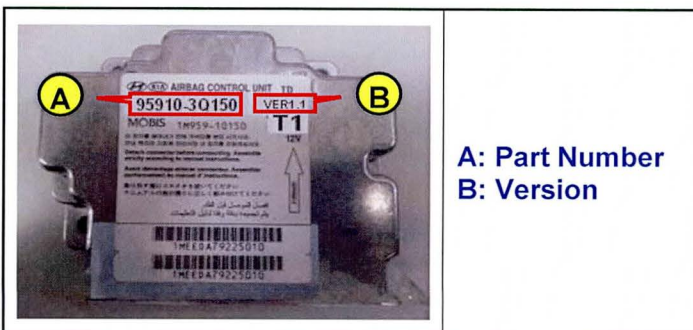
