### DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit wind noise that occurs from the rear door quarter glass while driving at approx. 25 mph (40Km/h). The noise may be caused by a gap between the rear door quarter glass and the rear door garnish. A soft pad has been attached to the rear door quarter glass guide to eliminate the noise.



Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

## REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify the wind noise occurs by putting masking tape (A) to cover the gap between the rear door quarter glass and the rear door garnish. Test drive the vehicle to verify if the wind noise is gone or not.
  - If the wind noise is gone, proceed to next step of the service bulletin repair procedure.
  - If the wind noise is still present, this repair is not applicable. Proceed to section 09 of MS3 online or the Workshop Manual for additional repair procedures.



- 2. Remove the rear door quarter glass and rear door quarter glass guide from the vehicle according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 09-12 REAR DOOR QUARTER GLASS REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).
- 3. Cut a 5mm x 100mm rectangle from the soft pad.

- 4. Degrease and clean the shaded area of the rear door quarter glass guide (A).
- 5. Attach the pad (B) in the shaded area.



 Re-install the rear door quarter glass and rear door quarter glass guide to the vehicle according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 09-12 REAR DOOR QUARTER GLASS REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).

NOTE: Avoid gap between pad and wedge lip (C).

7. Test drive the vehicle again to verify the wind noise is gone.
