DESCRIPTION


Some customers may experience a power liftgate (PLG) that closes but does not latch completely when the PLG button is pressed.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

Replace the PLG driver, PLG slider and PLG control module.

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Disconnect the negative battery cable.
- 3. Replace the PLG driver and PLG slider (A). Refer to MS3 online or Workshop Manual:
 - PLG driver section 09-11 POWER LIFTGATE (PLG) DRIVE UNIT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - PLG slider section 09-11 POWER LIFTGATE (PLG) SLIDER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION
 - NOTE: Install with 4 new bolts and torque them to 61.1 86.7 in-lbf (70.4 99.9 kgf-cm).



 Replace the PLG control module (B). Refer to MS3 online or Workshop Manual (section 09-11 POWER LIFTGATE (PLG) CONTROL MODULE REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).

NOTE: Install with 2 new bolts and torque them to 61.1 - 86.7 in-lbf (70.4 - 99.9 kgf-cm).
