Introduction

Some 2010 - 2013 model year GX 460 vehicles may exhibit a front brake squeak noise when coming to a stop from 10 - 0 mph. A new front brake rotor has been made available to address this condition.

Front Brake Squeak Noise

Repair Procedure

- 1. Test drive the vehicle to confirm that the noise is coming from the front brakes.
- 2. Remove and replace the front brake rotors.

NOTE

Please do NOT apply any grease to the pads or shims.
