2013 Avalon vehicles are equipped with 2 front and 2 rear torque box holes located in the lower section of the body.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The oval-shaped rubber body plugs should be installed in the 4 torque box holes during Pre-Delivery Service (PDS).

Installation of the rubber body plugs reduces cabin noise and prevents moisture from entering the body.




Figure 3. Rear Tie-Down Location - Before Installation




Figure 2. Front Tie-Down Location - After Installation





Figure 4. Rear Tie-Down Location - After Installation
