RB5 RE2 RB6 RE6 RE3 RB4 RE9 RE4 RE7 Radio Display Will Reset

OVERVIEW:

This Bulletin involves replacing the radio if needed.

MODELS:

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles built on or before June 21, 2013 (MDH 0621XX) equipped with one of the following radios.

- UConnect Touch 8.4N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (sales code RB5).
- UConnect Touch 8.4 CD/DVD/MP3 (sales code RE2).
- UConnect Touch 8.4N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (sales code RB6),
- UConnect Touch 8.4 CD/DVD/MP3 (sales code RE6).
- UConnect Touch 8.4 CD/DVD/MP3/ (sales code RE3).
- UConnect Touch 8.4N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (sales code RB4).
- Media CTR 641N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (China) (sales code RE9),
- Media CTR 641N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (Japan) (sales code RE4),
- Media CTR 641N CD/DVD/MP3/NAV (S.K.) (sales code RE7),

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may experience a radio reset. When the reset happens the radio display becomes white, then black, then back to a normal radio display. Sometimes audio is lost but then comes back as well. Radio will recover back to a normal display in about 3 - 5 seconds. On further inspection **NO** DTC will be found for this condition.

DIAGNOSIS:

Using a Scan Tool (wiTECH) with the appropriate Diagnostic Procedures available in TechCONNECT, verify no audio DTC's are set. If DTCs are present record them on the repair order and repair as necessary before proceeding further with this bulletin.

If the customer describes the symptom, perform the Repair Procedure.

NOTE: The radios need to be ordered from the exchange centers.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

- 1. Using wiTECH, determine what level the TGW/radio part number is. The radio part number can be found under Module Information for the radio.
- NOTE: Using the part list above, compare the radios part number in the vehicle to the one on the parts list. Example: The radio part number in the vehicle is 012345678AE and the one on the parts list is Z12345678AF, the one in the vehicle is lower and should be replaced.
- 2. Is the part number in the vehicles radio at the same level or higher then the one on the bulletins parts list?

a. Yes>>> This bulletin does not pertain, normal diagnostic needs to be performed.

- b. No >>> Proceed to Step #3.
- 3. Replace the TGW/radio.
- 4. Remove the TGW 08 Electrical/8E Electronic Control Modules/MODULE, Telematics Gateway/Removal.
- 5. Write down the serial number off the **replacement** radio before installing the new part. This will be needed when obtaining the Anit-theft code.
- 6. Install the TGW 08 Electrical/8E Electronic Control Modules/MODULE, Telematics Gateway/Installation.

NOTE: An Anit-Theft code will be needed to unlock the radio. To obtain the theft code refer to service bulletin 08-011-12.

7. Using the wiTech clear any DTC that may have been set before replacing the radio.
